1	Genesis 1:1, In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.	
2	Genesis 2:7, Then the Lord God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.	
3	Exodus 14:14, The Lord will fight for you. You need only to be still.	
4	Exodus 20:3, You must not have any other God but me. (Commandment 1)	
5	Exodus 20:7, You must not misuse the name of the Lord your God. The Lord will not let you go unpunished if you misuse his name. (Commandment 2)	
6	Exodus 20:8, Remember to observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. (Commandment 3)	
7	Exodus 20:12, Honor your father and mother. Then you will live a long, full life in the land the Lord your God is giving you. (Commandment 4)	
8	Exodus 20:13, You must not murder. (Commandment 5)	
9	Exodus 20:14, You must not commit adultery. (Commandment 6)	
10	Exodus 20:15, You must not steal. (Commandment 7)	
11	Exodus 20:16, You must not testify falsely against your neighbor. (Commandment 8)	
12	Exodus 20:17, You must not covet your neighbor's house. You must not covet your neighbor's wife, male or female servant, ox or donkey, or anything else that belongs to your neighbor. (Commandments 9 & 10)	
13	Leviticus 20:26, You must be holy because I, the Lord, am holy. I have set you apart from all other people to be my very own.	
14	Numbers 23:19, God is not a man, so he does not lie. He is not human, so he does not change his mind. Has he ever spoken and failed to act?	
15	Deuteronomy 7:9, Understand, therefore, that the Lord your God is indeed God. He is the faithful God who keeps his covenant for a thousand generations and lavishes his unfailing love on those who love him and obey his commands.	
16	Deuteronomy 31:8, Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the Lord will personally go ahead of you. He will be with you; he will neither fail you nor abandon you.	
17	Joshua 1:8, Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do.	
18	Joshua 1:9, This is my command – be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.	
19	Judges 3:9a, But when the people of Israel cried out to the Lord for help, the Lord raised up a rescuer to save them.	
20	Ruth 1:16, But Ruth replied, "Don't ask me to leave you and turn back. Wherever you go, I will go; wherever you live, I will live. Your people will be my people, and your God will be my God."	

21	I Samuel 16:7, But the Lord said to Samuel, "Don't judge by his appearance or height, for I have rejected him. The Lord doesn't see things the way you see them. People judge by outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."	
22	2 Samuel 7:22, How great you are, O Sovereign Lord! There is no one like you. We have never heard of another God like you!	
23	I Kings 8:39, Then hear from heaven where you live, and forgive. Give your people what their actions deserve, for you alone know each human heart.	
24	2 Kings 22:19, You were sorry and humbled yourself before the Lord when you heard what I said against this city and its people...I have indeed heard you, says the Lord.	
25	I Chronicles 29:17, I know, my God, that you examine our hearts and rejoice when you find integrity there. You know I have done all this with good motives, and I have watched your people offer their gifts willingly and joyously.	
26	2 Chronicles 7:14, Then if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land.	
27	Ezra 7:10, This was because Ezra had determined to study and obey the Law of the Lord and to teach those decrees and regulations to the people of Israel.	
28	Nehemiah 9:5, "...Stand up and praise the Lord your God, for he lives from everlasting to everlasting! Then they prayed: 'May your glorious name be praised! May it be exalted above all blessing and praise!'"	
29	Esther 4:14, If you keep quiet at a time like this, deliverance and relief for the Jews will arise from some other place, but you and your relatives will die. Who knows if perhaps you were made queen for just such a time as this?	
30	Job 19:25, But as for me, I know that my Redeemer lives, and he will stand upon the earth at last.	
31	Job 28:28, The fear of the Lord – that is wisdom, and to shun evil is understanding.	
32	Psalms 51:10, Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.	
33	Psalms 119:11, I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against You.	
34	Psalms 139:11-12, I could ask the darkness to hide me and the light around me to become night – but even in darkness I cannot hide from you. To you the night shines as bright as the day. Darkness and light are the same to you.	
35	Proverbs 3:5-6, Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.	
36	Ecclesiastes 5:5, It is better to say nothing than to make a promise and not keep it.	

37	Song of Songs 2:4, He escorts me to the banquet hall; it's obvious how much he loves me.	
38	Isaiah 9:6, For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Might God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.	
39	Isaiah 40:28, Have you never heard? Have you never understood? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of all the earth. He never grows weak or weary. No one can measure the depths of his understanding.	
40	Isaiah 40:30, Even youths will become weak and tired, and young men will fall in exhaustion.	
41	Isaiah 40:31, But those who trust in the Lord will find new strength. They will soar on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint.	
42	Jeremiah 29:11, For I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord, plans for your good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.	
43	Lamentations 3:22, The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease.	
44	Ezekiel 36:26, And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart.	
45	Daniel 2:44, During the reigns of those kings, the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be destroyed or conquered. It will crush all these kingdoms into nothingness, and it will stand forever.	
46	Hosea 14:8, O Israel, stay away from idols! I am the one who answers your prayers and cares for you. I am like a tree that is always green; all your fruit comes from me.	
47	Joel 2:32a, But everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.	
48	Amos 9:15, I will firmly plant them there in their own land. They will never again be uprooted from the land I have given them, says the Lord your God.	
49	Obadiah 1:21, Those who have been rescued will go up to Mount Zion in Jerusalem to rule over the mountains of Edom. And the Lord himself will be king!	
50	Jonah 1:9, Jonah answered, "I am a Hebrew, and I worship the Lord, the God of heaven, who made the sea and the land."	
51	Micah 6:8, No, O people, the Lord has told you what is good, and this is what he requires of you: to do what is right, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God.	
52	Nahum 1:7, The Lord is good, a strong refuge when trouble comes. He is close to those who trust in him.	
53	Habakkuk 2:4, "Look at the proud! They trust in themselves, and their lives are crooked. But the righteous will live by their faithfulness to God.	
54	Zephaniah 3:17, For the Lord your God is living among you. He is a mighty savior. He will take delight in you with gladness. With his love, he will calm all your fears. He will rejoice over you with joyful songs.	
55	Haggai 1:5 (NIV), Now this is what the Lord Almighty says: "Give careful thought to your ways."	

56	Zechariah 4:6, Then he said to me, This is what the Lord says to Zerubbabel: It is not by force nor by strength, but by my Spirit, says the Lord of Heaven's Armies.	
57	Malachi 3:10, Bring all the tithes into the storehouse...If you do, says the Lord of Heaven's Armies, "I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take it in!"	
58	Matt. 11:28, Come to me, all who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest.	
59	Matt. 11:29, Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.	
60	Matthew 6:20-21, Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be.	
61	Mark 10:45, For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many.	
62	Luke 16:13, No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and be enslaved to money.	
63	John 1:1-2, In the beginning the Word already existed. The Word was with God, and the Word was God. He existed in the beginning with God.	
64	John 14:27, I am leaving you with a gift – peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid.	
65	Acts 4:12, There is salvation in no one else! God has given no other name under heaven by which we must be saved.	
66	Romans 5:8, But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.	
67	Romans 8:28, And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them.	
68	Rom. 8:38, For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels or demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth can separate us from the love of Christ.	
69	Rom. 8:39, No power in the sky above or in the earth below-indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.	
70	I Corinthians 12:12, Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ.	
71	I Corinthians 13:13, Three things will last forever – faith, hope, and love – and the greatest of these is love.	
72	I Corinthians 15:58, So, my dear brothers and sisters, be strong and immovable. Always work enthusiastically for the Lord, for you know that nothing you do for the Lord is ever useless.	
73	2 Corinthians 2:14, But thank God! He has made us his captives and continues to lead us along in Christ's triumphal procession. Now he uses us to spread the knowledge of Christ everywhere, like a sweet perfume.	

74	2 Corinthians 4:18, So we fix our eyes on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.	
75	Galatians 2:20, My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.	
76	Galatians 5:22-23, But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.	
77	Ephesians 2:8-9, For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God. Not by works, so that no one can boast.	
78	Ephesians 1:4, Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes.	
79	Philippians 4:4-5, Always be full of joy in the Lord. I say it again – rejoice! Let everyone see that you are considerate in all you do. Remember, the Lord is coming soon.	
80	Philippians 4:6, Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done.	
81	Colossians 3:23, Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people.	
82	1 Thessalonians 5:18, Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus.	
83	2 Thessalonians 3:13, As for the rest of you, dear brothers and sisters, never get tired of doing good.	
84	1 Timothy 1:5, The purpose of my instruction is that all believers would be filled with love that comes from a pure heart, a clear conscience, and genuine faith.	
85	2 Timothy 3:16, All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right.	
86	Titus 3:5, He saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit.	
87	Philemon 1:6, I am praying that you will put into action the generosity that comes from your faith as you understand and experience all the good things we have in Christ.	
88	Heb. 12:1, Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses, let throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us.	
89	Heb. 12:2, We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith. Because of the joy awaiting him, he endured the cross, disregarding its shame. Now he is seated in the place of honor beside God's throne.	
90	James 1:22, Don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves.	
91	James 1:27, Pure and genuine religion in the sight of God the Father means caring for orphans and widows in their distress and refusing to let the world corrupt you.	

92	James 4:7, Humble yourselves before God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.	
93	1 Peter 3:15 (NIV), But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect.	
94	2 Peter 3:9, The Lord isn't really being slow about his promise, as some people think. No, he is being patient for your sake. He does not want anyone to be destroyed, but wants everyone to repent.	
95	1 John 4:7, Dear friends, let us continue to love one another, for love comes from God. Anyone who loves is a child of God and knows God.	
96	2 John 1:6, Love means doing what God has commanded us, and he has commanded us to love one another, just as you heard from the beginning.	
97	3 John 1:11 (NIV), Dear friend, don't let this bad example influence you. Follow only what is good. Remember that those who do good prove that they are God's children, and those who do evil prove that they do not know God.	
98	Jude 1:21, Keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life.	
99	Revelation 3:20, Look! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in, and we will share a meal together as friends.	
100	Revelation 21:6, He said to me: "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will give water without cost from the spring of the water of life."
