

Special Services

Special Services refers to any service provided to the student outside the realm of the regular classroom.

The services are designed to either enhance or remediate a student's academic progress. These programs come at an additional cost per year, charged to the family TADS account.

RESPONSE TO INTERVENTION

All instructional strategies are research-based.

Tri-annual benchmarking determines the need and level for intervention.

Tier I: Classroom Intervention

Intervention is provided for all students as part of the regular educational curriculum by the classroom teacher. Students with reading and math skills determined to be below the benchmark are identified and progress-monitored. No cost.

Tier II: Small Group Intervention

Intervention is provided for students whose progress- monitoring indicates skills are still not at grade level and require more intensive intervention. When skills improve to grade level students are dismissed and continue to be monitored by benchmarks in the regular classroom. Those whose skills do not improve with Tier II intervention are referred for formal evaluation.

Tier III: Intensive Small Group Intervention

Intervention is provided by a therapist to students who have a formally diagnosed learning difference, disorder or physical limitation, whose skills are not at grade level and require intensive intervention.

Masters Program

The MASTERS Program is designed to enhance skills for the High Ability Learner, in grades 1st - 4th. A "High Ability" learner is a student who performs at, or shows the potential of performing at an outstanding level of accomplishment in at least one domain when compared with other students at the same age, experience or environment.

A student may be identified as "High Ability" in either Language Arts, Mathematics, or both. Instruction will be tailored to enhance and extend the curriculum of the regular classroom and will crosscurricular with one or more of the following subject areas:

Masters Program:

Program, students are identified by a team of administrators and teachers using data from achievement, intellectual and benchmark testing as well as a classroom checklist.

After School Enrichment Opportunities

Academic Team \$300 per year
