YOUR SCHEDULE FOR THE DAY



DROP OFF

School doors open at 7:35am. Please arrive between 7:35 & 7:45 am on your shadow day.



CHECK IN

The first step is check-in at the School Office. Fill out a nurse form and get a student badge.



CLASS

Student is placed in current grade level to meet future classmates.



TESTING

Benchmark testing is scheduled during the morning of the shadow day visit.



PICK UP

Pick up times vary by age of student. We will share your pick up time when you schedule your shadow day.



What is a Benchmark test?

During your student's shadow day, there will be a benchmark test administered. This test lasts 30 - 45 minutes. The results give us data on your student's current level in reading, writing, and math. We use this information to ensure that Salem can meet your student's academic needs.
