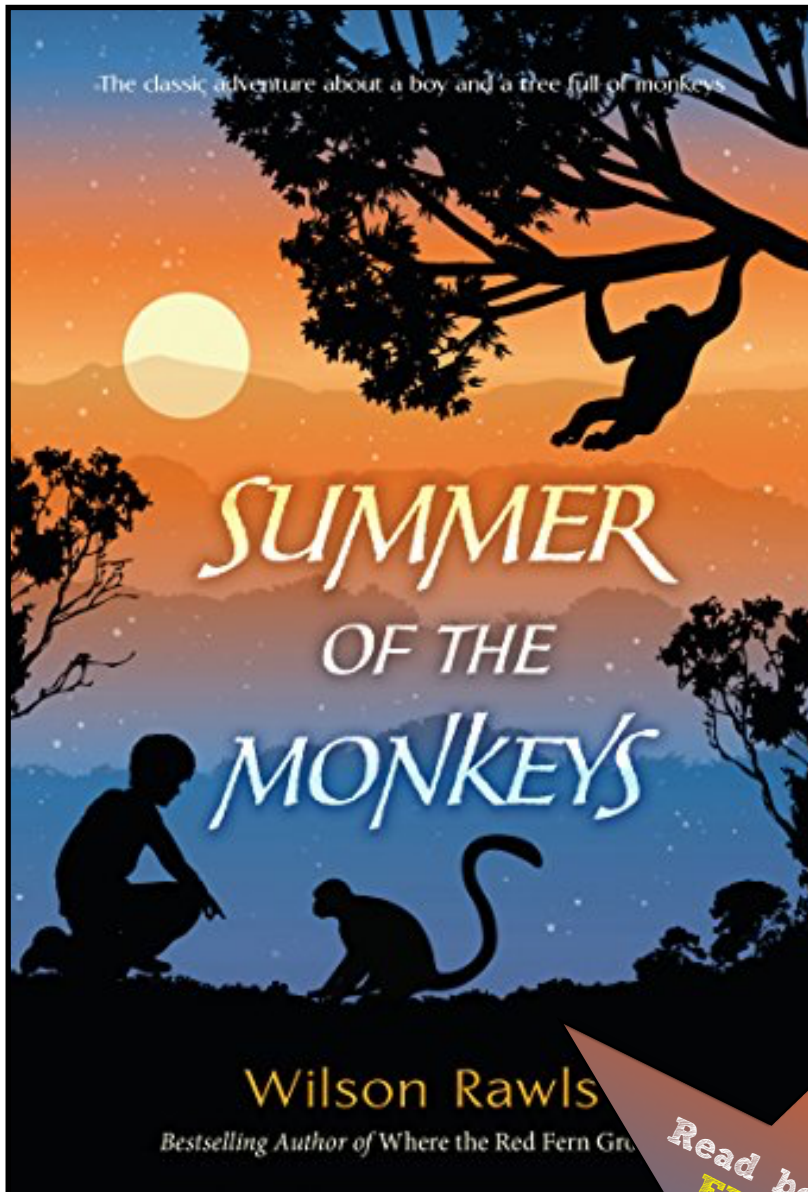


8th Grade Summer Reading
