

SALEM SAINTS VOLLEYBALL CONTRACT 2020

1. Players attend all practices, games, and tournaments
2. Parents are to drive their daughter to all games, or arrange for transportation
3. Team Moms will set schedules for parents to work concession stand, gate, line judge, and work clock and book. Parents are to help in at least one of these areas.
4. Players must have a physical on file and sign Salem's Athletic contract **BEFORE tryouts begin.**
5. Players maintain passing grades in all classes and are positive examples in conduct

REQUIREMENTS OF PLAYERS

Have the proper attire and equipment for every practice. This includes wearing PE clothes (PE shorts or black shorts are allowed), kneepads, having hair pulled back, no jewelry on, and gym shoes. Players must bring their own water bottle.

Follow the Safety Protocols as instructed by the coaches to ensure the health and safety of our team and coaches.

Complete "Early Bird Special" by 3:30.

Hustle between all drills, shagging volleyballs, when being called in by the coach, etc.

Be a team player.

Compete for your role - don't expect it, don't complain, and do your best with the talents and abilities God has blessed you with.

Clean your area in the gym daily so that no personal belongings are left behind.

Help clean up after home games (if allowed).

Treat players, coaches, officials, and fans with respect.

Encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials, and parents at every game and model it yourself.

Be coachable. Do your best to listen and learn from your coaches.

Attend every practice and game. If you will miss, the respective coach must be notified. Acceptable excused absences are: attending a funeral, doctor appointment, illness, and tutoring for academics (athlete should attend partial practice at coach's discretion). Missing practice or a game means you will not start the next game and may not play (coach's discretion). If you have an unexcused absence from practice the first time, the consequences are running 10 horses. A second unexcused absence will result in 10 horses, you explaining to your teammates why you were not in practice, and writing a letter to your coach explaining the absence. A third unexcused absence will result in you no longer being a part of the team.

Model a Christ-like, Christ-centered life.

If you have a social media account, it is known that what you post represents Salem, but more importantly, who we are as Christians. Being well-rounded and well-grounded in Christ, you should give thought about what you post and make sure any comments, posts, pictures, etc. reflect positively on Salem. Coaches reserve the right for disciplinary action if postings are found to reflect negatively.

Maintain academic eligibility while doing your best to promote academic excellence.

Be positive about this experience in volleyball and accept responsibility for your actions.

Remember that team sports are an opportunity to learn, have fun, and be a part of something bigger than yourself. Represent Salem, your coach, your parents, and God to the best of your ability.

Parents **MUST** volunteer to work at a minimum of 2 home games (i.e. clock, concessions, gate, etc.) Team moms will assign roles.
