Early Childhood FAQs

When was Salem School established?

Our elementary school was established in 1853, celebrating more than 172 years in ministry. Preschool began in 1981, celebrating over 44 years in ministry.

What Preschool programs are offered?

We offer full-time, two, three and five day a week programs from birth through pre-kindergarten.

Can my child attend elementary school at Salem?

Yes. Salem Lutheran School educates through the eighth grade.

What is Salem Lutheran Preschool's philosophy?

We adhere to the philosophy of educating the "whole child", mind, body and soul. Children are given the opportunity to grow and learn at their own pace and in their own way. The emphasis of the program is planned, purposeful play that allows the children to learn from hands-on experiences; thus enhancing pre-reading, pre-language and pre-math skills. The children are guided positively so that they can become responsible and caring individuals; self-motivated and self-controlled.

Is Salem Lutheran Preschool licensed?

Yes. We adhere to the licensing criteria of Texas Health and Human Services, the Harris County Fire Marshal, and the Harris County Health Department.

Is Salem Lutheran Preschool accredited?

Yes. We are accredited by the Lutheran School Accreditation Committee.

What type of curriculum is used?

We believe that children learn best through hands-on experiences, genuine curiosity, and being active partners in the learning process. Our teachers use thematic units to guide activities and concepts, while also following the unique interests of each child to keep learning engaging and meaningful.

All age groups enjoy a weekly Music and Movement class, promoting rhythm, coordination, self-regulation, and joyful expression. We emphasize process art, giving children the freedom to explore a variety of materials and express themselves creatively without limits.

Our faith-based learning is rooted in Enduring Faith (Concordia Publishing House), while social-emotional development is supported by Conscious Discipline and Friendly, helping children build empathy, resilience, and healthy relationships.

In Pre-K, we introduce more structured academic curriculum including Heggerty for phonemic awareness, Saxon Math for foundational skills, and Learning Without Tears for handwriting development.

To enrich the learning journey, we also host in-house field trips, inviting special guests and interactive experiences that help bring new concepts to life.
